The pamphlets, grey literature, and ephemera in this collection form an invaluable resource for the study of the political, economic, and social conditions of Latin America during the greater part of the twentieth century. The collection is particularly valuable for the rapidly growing field of Latin American labor studies. It is also strong in its representation of diverse political opinion. Other important subjects include agriculture, arts, the Catholic Church, civil liberties, finance, foreign relations, human rights, indigenous peoples, industrialization, land reform, race relations, trade, women's rights, and many others.

Robert J. Alexander

This collection is primarily based on the personal archive of Robert J. Alexander (b. 1918), Professor of Economics and Political Science at Rutgers University for over fifty years. Robert J. Alexander traveled throughout Latin America hundreds of times and is the author of forty-six books and numerous articles and reviews. The collection also contains pamphlets donated by other scholars, such as Frances R. Grant and the Argentine novelist and Rutgers faculty member Tomás Eloy Martínez.

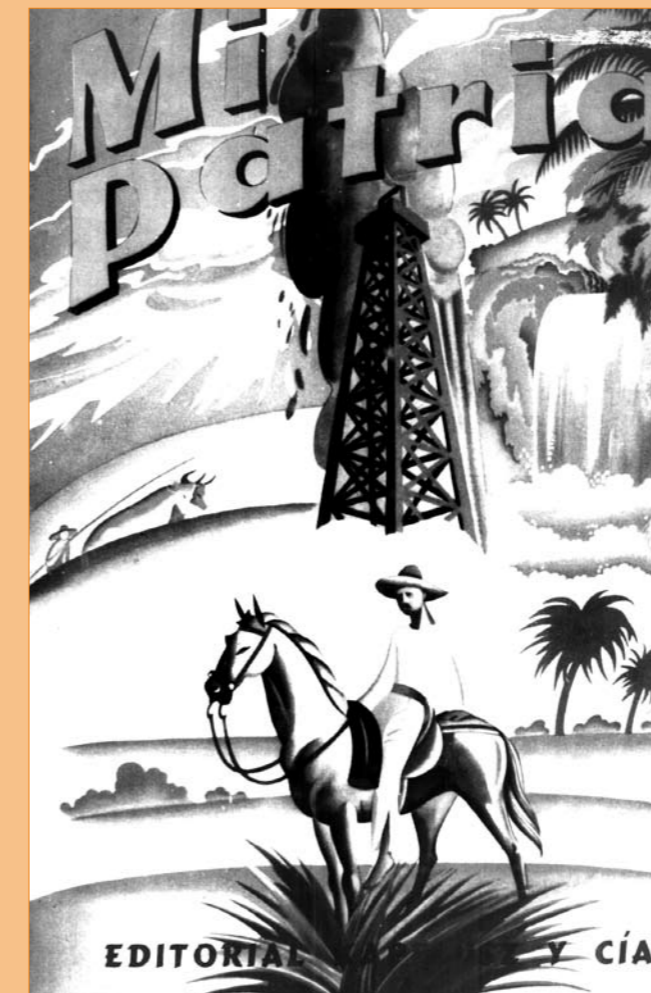
